- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Jerome Gnatek, and the prayer was led by Wade Lamb.
- 3. Answering roll call was Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 4. Citizen Comments--None.
- 5. Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest made the motion to approve the minutes from the December 02, 2019 regular meeting, and purchase orders for the Utility Fund, General Fund, Street & Alley, Fireman's Fund, and Meter Deposits Payable. Dorothy Perkins seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 6. There were no consideration of items to be removed from the Consent Agenda.
- 7. No action--Robbie Squires, Director of Government & Regulatory Affairs from Cox Communications to address the council and possible action regarding a utility pole attachment agreement.
- 8. Justin Buckley made the motion to approve a Certificate of Compliance for potential OMMA Business for Ken DeVore/Joe McCarthy. David Rexwinkle seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek. Mayor Jerome Gnatek advised Mr. McCarthy the town would not provide materials to get 3 phase electricity.
- 9. No action--Discussion and possible action regarding the approval of a bid award in the amount of \$499,489.60 to Bruce Davis Construction for the Town of South Coffeyville's Street Rehabilitation/Construction Project # 16998 CDBG-17 and associated documents; contingent upon the Town's Attorney's and Engineer's approval.
- 10. Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest made the motion to approve Mayor Jerome Gnatek to attend OML Budget Process Workshop on January 10, 2020 in Midwest City that will include mileage, meals, and hotel room (1 night). Justin Buckley seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.

He will receive a \$0.50 raise.
- 13. VIce Mayor Kenneth Vest made the motion to refund \$595.00 Marijuana License Fee to Roger Thompson and to Marty Frye. David Rexwinkle seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 14. Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest made the motion to table the vote to abolish the old library and transform that section of the building into an office for the Maintenance Department. Dorothy Perkins seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek. A resolution needed to be checked first. A resolution would need to be referred to.
- 15. Justin Buckley made the motion to table the vote to let Reserves use Gibbs Hall June 12-July 5 for Reserve Officers to sell fireworks. Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest seconded the motion. Yes vote were made by Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek. A city ordinance needed to be checked.
