

**MINUTES OF THE

1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jerome Gnatek.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Jerome Gnatek, and the prayer was led by Janie Conley.

2. Answering roll call was Dorothy Perkins, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek. David Rexwinkle was absent.

4. Citizen Comments—None.

5. Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest made the motion to approve the minutes from the June 7, 2021 regular meeting, and purchase orders for the Utility Fund, General Fund, Street & Alley, Fireman's Fund, and Meter Deposits Payable.
