- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Jerome Gnatek, and the prayer was led by Wade Lamb.
- 3. Answering roll call was Dorothy Perkins, Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 4. Citizen Comments--None.
- 5. Dorothy Perkins made the motion to approve the minutes from the August 16, 2021 regular meeting with the correction to remove line item #9 and September 7, 2021 regular meeting, and purchase orders for the Utility Fund, General Fund, Street & Alley, Fireman's Fund, and Meter Deposits Payable. Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 6. There were no consideration of items to be removed from the Consent Agenda.
- 7. Sarah Key with the South Coffeyville Area Development Authority addressed the council with a project status update. She reported that the building was 95% complete with some final electrical and plumbing projects to be completed. Three of the units have been spoken for, with one already having a lease signed. One unit is still available for rent. SCADA meets the 2nd Tuesday of every month at 1:00 p.m. at City Hall.
- 8. No action--Adrian Davis with Wake Wireless to address the council about setting up their internet on the town's water tower.
- 9. A letter was reviewed from a citizen with concerns regarding a previous appointment to the council. A Special Meeting was decided upon to appoint a trustee to the vacant council seat to take place September 27, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall. Joe Scott's Trustee appointment was after the 60 day deadline to appoint a trustee to a vacant seat and is null and void.
- 10. Dorothy Perkinse made the motion to purchase a R1 GNSS Receiver in the amount of \$2,368.00 out of the Utility Fund. This will also be used by the Fire Department and Emergency Management. Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.



- 11. Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle made the motion to purchase a SensorLink Ampstik Plus High Voltage Ammeters in the amount of \$2,352.44. Dorothy Perkins seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
- 12. Dorothy Perkins made the motion to approve changes to the Fee Schedule for A-B3 Rock and 40-Foot Utility Poles. Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle seconded the motion. Yes votes were made by Dorothy Perkins, Vice Mayor David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.

Report from Jim Wilson, Fire Chief --Absent. Steve Soules reported there was a class in McAlister that some had attended and the #42 fire truck was back from the shop.

Report from Steven Soule, Superintendent for Maintenance Department--Reported the update on water study was in the packet.

Report from Jenifer Hanigan, Deputy Clerk --Reported a letter had been sent to Kenneth Vest about being the town's safety coordinator, the grievance reply letter from the committee had been sent. New handbooks had been ordered to be available to view. The Fireworks donation account had received \$263.00 from the scrap metal being turned in. She had included the information on nepotism in the packet. The REAP Grant filed an extension for the SCADA building and a letter had been received to extend the time to 12/31/21. She would have Jessica Mansfield's pay with benefits at the next meeting if she was to go full time with the budgets.
