1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Jerome Gnatek, and the prayer was led by Wade Lamb.
3. Answering roll call was Dorothy Perkins, Justin Buckley, Vice Mayor Kenneth Vest, David Rexwinkle, and Mayor Jerome Gnatek.
4. Citizen Comments--None.
5. David Rexwinkle made the motion to approve the minutes from the April 06, 2020 regular meeting, and purchase orders for the Utility Fund, General Fund, Street & Alley, Fireman's Fund, and Meter Deposits Payable. **Report from Jenifer Hanigan, Deputy Clerk** --Reported that the town's IT was looking into setting up a safe internet connection to help local kids access internet.

**Report from Mitch Lakey, Emergency Manager** --Reported the food distribution went well. He also assisted Nowata County Emergency Management with the drive through testing last week. Tornado sirens had been tested, and they are waiting on a frame to reinstall the other siren at the fire department.
